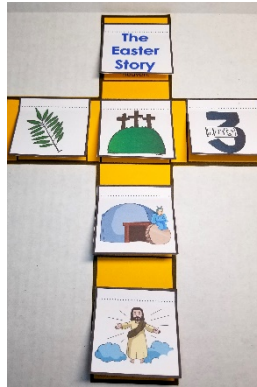
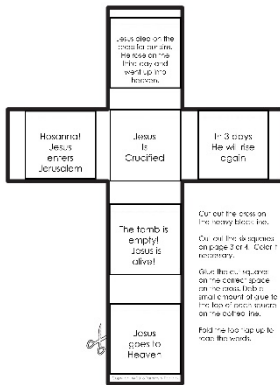


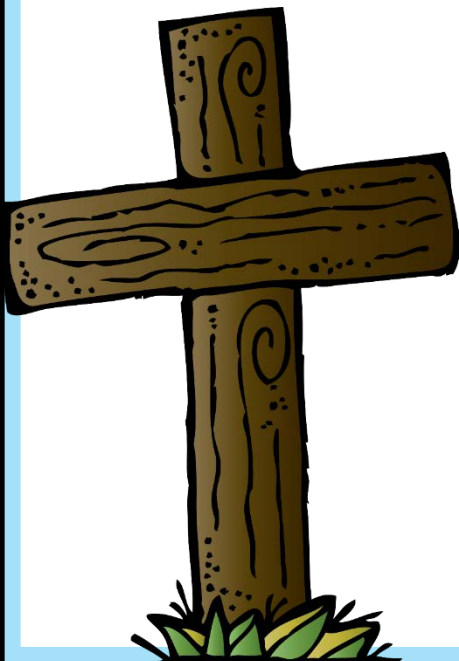
# Retelling

Cut out each square on the black line. Glue to the correct space on the cross. Fold the square up on the dotted line to read the words underneath.

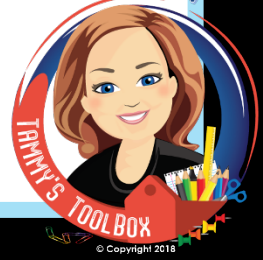

read the words.

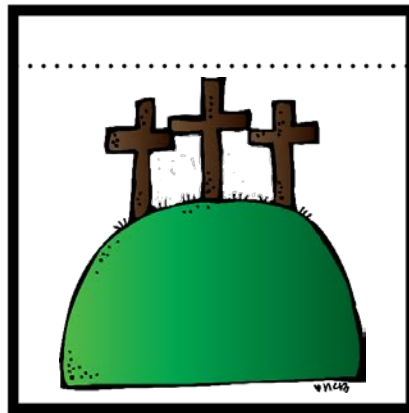
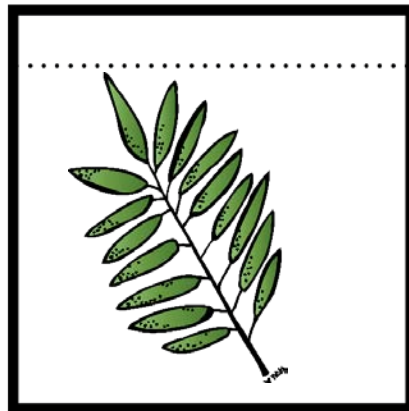
